


Good afternoon and welcome to our first concert of the 2025/26 Season. You will hear music by the greatest composers who have ever put pen to paper: Fauré, Elgar, Saint-Saëns, Brahms, Sibelius, and Beethoven. We are proud to feature orchestra member Erica Mancuso as violin soloist in Introduction and Rondo Capriccioso by Saint -Saëns. Here's a coincidence for you: in 1918, the manager of the Opéra de Monte-Carlo invited Gabriel Fauré to write a short work for the theatre, the impetus coming from Fauré's friend and former teacher Camille Saint-Saëns who suggested to Prince Albert that he should commission Fauré to write a short work for the Monte Carlo opera. We will play the Ouverture from Fauré's suite Masques et Bergamasques to begin our season. Elgar wrote his Salut d'Amour for his fiancée Alice, a published writer, in return for a poem she had written for him. Brahms composed his Serenade in D major as a compositional study before attempting to write a full-scale symphony. His goal was to develop his skill and technique until he was satisfied that his music would be comparable to Beethoven's achievements as a symphonic composer, whose music he revered. Aside from Brahms, the composers we feature today were born in the 19th century and lived well into the 20th century, making for an interesting study in the different and similar ways in which these composers wrote for orchestra. We close out the first half with Sibelius's Nocturne. another piece written for the theatre.

Beethoven wrote his Heiligenstadt Testament on October 6, 1802 to his brothers Carl and Johann. This is a letter reflecting his growing despair at his increasing deafness. He wrote his Fourth Symphony in the summer of 1806 and it was premiered in March 1807. The orchestra at Lobkowitz Palace in Vienna was exactly the same size as the Sault Symphony Orchestra you will hear today.



The Sault Symphony Orchestra is honoured to be the 2025 recipient of the Vida Peene Award, presented by the Ontario Arts Council.

Established in 1978 through a bequest from Vida Peene (1898–1978), a devoted arts patron from Hamilton, this biennial award recognizes artistic and organizational excellence among Ontario's professional, semi-professional, and community orchestras — excluding the Toronto Symphony Orchestra.

Valued at \$5,000, the award celebrates orchestras that make outstanding contributions to the cultural life of their communities.

This recognition reflects the hard work, dedication, and passion of our musicians, board, and volunteers.

The award will be presented this afternoon by Carolyn Gloude of the Ontario Arts Council.
